Anna Elizabeth Jennings Williams, 102, of New Brunswick NJ., died on Tuesday, August 20, 2013 after an extended illness. Anna attended elementary and high school in New Brunswick, graduating in 1930. She also completed an additional year of advanced business studies at NBHS, and received a certificate from its Advanced Business Studies program in 1931. She was a faithful lifetime member of Mt. Zion A.M.E. Church for more than 88 years, and from a young age, was actively involved at church, where she served as the organist and choir director of the youth choir and as organist for the senior choir. She was also a proud member of the Willing Workers Club for 71 years. During the 20 year period that she lived in Washington, DC., she worshiped under watch-care at Turner Memorial A.M.E. Church. Anna began her professional career in 1942 and was primarily employed by the Department of the Army, serving in the secretarial and business fields for over 30 years in New Brunswick, New York, and Washington, DC. Always civic minded, she was a member of the New Brunswick Chapter of the NAACP, the Urban League Guild, the New Brunswick Health Club as well as Secretary of the Veterans Committee of New Brunswick during the war in years in the 1940's. She was predeceased by her parents, James E. and Edith Brown Jennings, and eight siblings. She leaves to cherish her memory a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.
