March 7, 1943 - May 6, 2023

Ausborne (Butch) Wong, a beloved husband, father, grandfather, and brother, passed away on May 6, 2023, at the tender age of 80.

Born on March 7, 1943 in Newark, NJ to Robert Pitts and Mabel Wong, he was educated in the Newark school system, and joined the Marines thereafter. Butch was a dedicated family man, that was preceded in death by both his parents and 10 of 12 of his siblings survived by his brother Robert Pitts of Piscataway, NJ, and sister Phyllis Wong of Tampa, Florida.

Always available to be present for any of his grandchildren's hockey, football, basketball, swimming, ballet and field hockey practices, games and team travels, Butch played a huge role in contributing to whatever interests there were for his family at the time. Always one to help with assisting his neighbors needs in bringing in their kids, grabbing their morning papers he was known as a gentle soul, a strong man of very few words that stood up for those when it mattered, always soft spoken, greeted all with a smile and specialized in thoughtful deeds by helping others. His heart was overflowing with goodness, and his sweet spirit will live in the hearts and memories of everyone that knew and loved him. His legacy will continue to live on through the many lives he touched and the memories he leaves behind.
