October 16, 1941 - June 12, 2022

Beryl Elsie Omomide Davis (nee Macauley) 80, of Parlin, NJ, died June 12, 2022.

It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of a dear grandmother, mother-in-law, sister, cousin, aunt, and friend. Beryl Elsie Omomide Davis was born in Freetown, Sierra Leone on October 16, 1941 to Josiah Ketiku and Amelia Beola Macauley (nee Wright). She received her Secondary School education at the Methodist Girls High School, Freetown where she was the Head girl in her senior year.

She landed her first banking career job at Barclays Bank, Freetown followed by the Bank of Sierra Leone. In 1973, she joined the Sierra Leone Commercial Bank as a Manager. During her tenure, she successfully completed several banking courses at the Midland Bank in London, UK and Ghana Commercial Bank in Accra, Ghana. She rose through the ranks to Director of Administration until her retirement in 2001. She later joined her daughter, Elmeryl and her family in New Jersey, USA.

Beryl Davis cherished a loving 'full house' environment as a result she fostered and financially-supported the education of many youths in Freetown, Sierra Leone.

Beryl Davis was predeceased by her husband, Elmsley in 2006 and their only daughter, Elmeryl in 2014. She is survived by her five grandsons (Jarel, Callan, Reyden, Leland & Delvyn Davies) and dedicated herself to their well-being; a son-in law (Julian Davies), siblings (Eku, Casey and Yvette), several

relatives and close friends in Sierra Leone, USA, Ghana, Nigeria, the Sierra Leone Commercial Bank and Aldersgate United Methodist Church families.

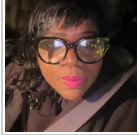

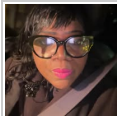
