June 9, 1941 - February 21, 2022

Beverly Leigh Hall Gutridge was born the second of four children to Elsie Mozella Staten Hall and Fisher Franklin Hall on June 9, 1941, in Manhattan, New York. Beverly was ushered into God's arms on February 21, 2022 at Riverview Medical Center, Red Bank, New Jersey. Beverly grew up in Harlem, New York and when she was a teenager the family moved from New York to Cliffwood, New Jersey. She graduated from Matawan High School.

Beverly was joined in Holy Matrimony to Joseph Lamar Gutridge Sr. on January 17, 1961, until the time of her passing. 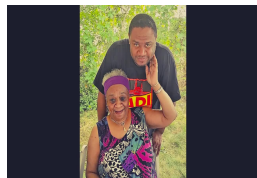
