Blondell Yvette Mills Of Trenton, NJ died February 3, 2026. Memorial service was held Saturday, February 28, 2026, at Anderson Funeral Service, 300 North Willow Street, Trenton, NJ.

“Blondell Yvette Mills was born on May 27, 1965, and was raised by her late, loving parents who instilled in her strong values and a deep love for family. Born in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, she relocated at an early age to Trenton, New Jersey, where she received most of her education and excelled academically, demonstrating a dedication to learning.

Family, especially her daughter Christina, was at the center of her world. She gave of herself selflessly, creating spaces of love, support, and understanding. Blondell also possessed a rare gift for writing, expressing thoughts and emotions with insight and sensitivity through letters, reflections, and quiet

moments of creativity. Her words carried comfort, wisdom, and truth, leaving a lasting legacy.

To know Blondell was to experience warmth, laughter, and a love that felt genuine and effortless. Her laugh was contagious, full, and sincere, breaking tension and lifting spirits. It reflected her kind-hearted, joyful, and compassionate personality, making everyone feel welcome and at home. Though her physical presence is no longer with us, her legacy lives on in the memories we hold, the meals we share, the words she left behind, and the love she taught us to give so freely. Her life was a beautiful story—written with intention, lived with purpose, and remembered with gratitude and love”.
