Carol was 72 when she got her new keys, on October 17, 2022. That night she sent me a message. It rained like a flood. Aunt D said, "...this is not rain as you know it, these are tears of joy, no more pain. Carol was born on January 15, 1950, in Dillon, South Carolina and she peacefully took her wings on the morning of October 17, 2022. Her family moved north to Trenton, NJ where she was educated in the Trenton Public School System and graduated from Trenton Central High School. From there she went to work for the State of New Jersey retiring October 1, 2004, with more than 30 years of service finishing her career in the Office of the Public Defender.
