June 24, 1943 - May 26, 2014

North Brunswick - Charles C. Singleton III, 70, of New Brunswick, died Monday at St. Peters University Hospital, New Brunswick.

Born in Trenton, NJ, he moved to New Brunswick in 1973. He was a member of St. Albans Episcopal Church, New Brunswick. He was a community activist and advocate. Charles was a former member of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference, National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, Poor Peoples Campaign and Frontier International. His outreach included young people through his former role as director of the Juvenile Delinquency Prevention Program in Trenton, NJ.

A veteran of the United States Army having served during the Vietnam War, he was a radiologist for the State of New Jersey and teacher with the Trenton Board of Education. Charles also was a supervisor at Johnson and Johnson, National Manager of Regulatory Affairs at Whatman, Inc. and a New Jersey Funeral Director at Anderson Funeral Service, New Brunswick and Trenton.
