



## Frances Margaret Salter

September 13, 1936 - February 22, 2019

Frances Margaret Salter was born in Atlantic City, New Jersey to parents Stephan and Mary Jackson on September 13, 1936. After her mother's death Frances went to school to learn dress making and became a Master Tailor, leading to work making army clothing and parachutes for the war effort. She went on to a successful career designing and modeling clothes.

At age twenty she moved to Trenton, NJ, married and had two children, Carol and Eddie Jr. At this time she also joined and was baptized in Shiloh Baptist Church.

Frances returned to school and college and received an Associates Degree in Social Science; a Bachelor's of Science Degree in Criminal Justice and attended Rutgers University Graduate School of Social Work. She was on the Dean's List several times and received various awards from the social clubs to which she belonged.

Frances worked many years in the judicial system starting as a counselor in the county jail and worked her way to director of Program Services for Inmates. As a Work Release Administrator she was the first Black female to hold the position in Mercer County.

After relocating to Dallas, TX, Frances finally settled in Tampa, FL. There she

worked for the FL Department of Corrections as a probation officer/parole officer before retiring in 2001.

Frances loved the outdoors enjoying, camping and RV'ing. Frances was an active member of the Blazer's Ski Club and as such traveled extensively throughout the United States and Europe. Her favorite places and experiences were in Paris, France enjoying history at the Louvre Museum and riding the gondolas in Venice, Italy. She was an avid book reader and loved word and crossword puzzles.

Frances is survived by her daughter Carol McRae, her son Edward Salter, Jr., granddaughter Juana Jackson, grandsons Kevin and Nicholas Salter, great-granddaughter Kelli Jackson, great-great granddaughter Bryanna, and her sister Theresa Jones. She is predeceased by her loving sisters Ruth and Dorothy, as well as brothers Junior and Leroy. Through them Frances begat a large and loving family of nieces and nephews whom she loved very much.
