



Bishop Horace Lee Staton

April 4, 1938 - January 12, 2015

Bishop Horace Lee Staton, 76, of Somerset, NJ, went Home to be with The Lord on January 12, 2015, at RWJUH, New Brunswick. Born in Oak City, NC, he formerly resided in New Brunswick and Freehold, NJ for many years.

In 1959, he joined Full Gospel Church, New Brunswick, in the Bible Way Church of Our Lord Jesus Christ, World Wide. He was ordained an Elder in 1979 and consecrated a Bishop in The Lord's Church in 1994. He currently served as District Bishop of the Northern New Jersey District and as a member on the Joint Board of Bishops. He was the Past Auxiliary Bishop of the International Clergy Wives and Widows Association and a member of the Ministerial Alliance of New Brunswick. In 1981, he founded Faith Temple Church in Somerset and served as Senior Pastor until his demise.

He was predeceased by his parents, Erma Staton and Hattie Knight Pittman, and four siblings, Erma Vonn Frazier, Ronald, Irving and Michael Pittman. Left to cherish his memory are his wife, Lydia L Staton; children, Rodney C. Staton and Cherelyn Staton-Hanson (Gregg); three granddaughters, Jasmine K. Staton, Nicole A. Staton-Vannell and Dejah K.
