Brother Howard Sims was born May 14, 1942 to Mable Sims and Howard Jones in Reading, Pennsylvania. He was the youngest of five children. He accepted Christ at an early age and united with Zion Baptist Church.

Howard graduated from Reading High School in 1961. He received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Mechanical Engineering from Drexel University and a Master's Degree from the University of Connecticut.

Upon graduation, he went to work for Electric Boat in Groton, Connecticut, where he designed nuclear powered submarines. After working there for 12 years, he moved to East Brunswick, New Jersey where he worked for Gibbs & Hill and Flour Daniel and built power plants. He then transitioned to work with the Port Authority of New York & New Jersey for 10 years, and retired in 2013.

Howard was a man of faith who was active in his church community. Once he settled in East Brunswick, he joined Sharon Baptist Church where he was a faithful member and served on the Trustee Board.

Howard married Gloria J. Bell on August 30, 1969 in Minden, Louisiana. To this union, two sons were born.

Howard was an avid sports fan. He enjoyed watching the Philadelphia Eagles

play on Sundays and coached his son's township basketball team. He also worked with both sons on their Boy Scout projects. Jason and Joshua have fond memories of many activities with their father, including how he enjoyed dramatically recited "Thus The Night Before Christmas" for every December 25th in their youth.
