Dr. Graham attended Butler High School in Hartsville, SC. Dr. Graham began his biblical studies in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. He attended the Philadelphia Biblical University, The Mannie Bible Institute and Eastern Baptist Seminary. Dr. Graham received his Bachelor and Masters degrees in Theology from Jamerson Bible College in Philadelphia, PA. He earned his Doctor of Divinity degree from Brownwell University in Tuston, GA. Dr. Graham completed advanced academic studies at Hampton University in Hampton, VA, Kings University in Roselle, New Jersey and New Brunswick Theological Seminary in New Brunswick, NJ.

With a wealth of knowledge and leadership abilities, Dr. Graham was the Director of Christian Education of the District Union of North Jersey, Secretary of the General Baptist State Convention of New Jersey, Member of the Executive Board of the Hampton University Ministers Conference, Board of Directors of the Northern School of Religion and Board Member at Large for the National Baptist Convention of Delaware.

Dr. Graham was also the author of two books: Commentary of Book of Revelations and Christ Through My Eyes. Dr. Leo H. Graham served as pastor of the Tabernacle Baptist Church of New Brunswick, NJ for the past 36 years. In his leisure time, Dr. Graham loved spending time with his family and watching his favorite shows "Law and Order" and "Judge Judy."
