Leroi Bruce Jones was born December 29, 1951, the youngest child of the late Alfred and Maymie Jones. Leroi, whom everyone called Bruce, was born and raised in Pleasantville, NJ. Early in Bruce's life, he developed a love for sports and entertainment. Bruce was one of the first African-American left handed pitchers in his youth baseball league. He also played football as a child where he was often written about in the local newspaper for his phenomenal sportsmanship.

As a child, Bruce attended Mt. Zion Baptist Church under the direction of Pastor Whitefield. His love for music blossomed in church with his brother and sister by his side. After graduating from Pleasantville High School in 1970, he then had his eldest son Juan. Bruce was invited to sing at Club Harlem in Atlantic City with his group, "The Pazaar's."
