Together they had three children, as Linda continued to grow in her career as a Supervisor of Customer Service at Yellow Pages. Linda loved to cook, and she thoroughly loved to bake. Her culinary skills were passed down from her Mother-in-Law, and she over the years perfected many dishes like her famous lasagna and stuffed shells. However, she is best known for her lemon meringue pie and cheesecake from scratch, as well as her family famous Strawberry Shortcake. Linda was fierce to the very end. She was hilarious.
