



## Lurline Ann Baxter

May 16, 1925 - July 6, 2018

Lurline Ann Baxter was born in Harlem, New York on May 16, 1925. She was the 2nd of 11 children to Leopold and Claudene LeGendre. She attended Central High School of Needle Trades in New York City and graduated 1943 with the plan of becoming a hat maker.

Although her hope was to become a hat maker, she accepted a job offer at the Municipal Management Society (MMS), formed in 1954. It was the first union #1180 which was organized in New York City for supervisory and administrative employees. She also worked as a secretary to the first Black President of NYC Municipal Civil Service Commission.

Lurline met the late Henry Baxter and they married on February 12, 1955. That union produced one daughter, Dannette Baxter. During her time on earth, she liked making hats, sewing clothes, listening to jazz, doing some travel, gambling at casinos and she enjoyed dining on seafood.

She leaves behind one daughter, Dannette Baxter and one grandson, Marquise Terrell Hall; one brother, Henri LeGendre; two sisters, Jean Crichlow and Claudene LeGendre. Her brothers and sisters who preceded her in death were Leroy Rae, John, Adrina, Pierre, Joan and Ruby. She is survived by a host of nieces, nephews, cousins and extended family members.
