Marcia Elise Burwell was born in Somerville, New Jersey, on September 12, 1954. She was the eldest daughter of McKinley and Leola Hill. Marcia departed this life on October 15, 2025.

During her childhood, she, along with her parents, attended Bethel Church of God in Christ in New Brunswick, New Jersey, under the leadership of the late Rev. Fred Croslin and the late Rev. Samuel Randolph. She accepted the Lord as her personal Savior at Progressive Church of God in Christ under the leadership of the late Elder Frank Brown. She later became a member of Church of God in Christ For All Saints in Morristown, New Jersey, under the leadership of the late Superintendent Gordon Rogers.

surrounding community, Progressive grew to nurture many souls. On Sunday afternoons, Pastor and First Lady would faithfully visit and minister to the sick and shut-in until God called Superintendent Burwell to his reward.

Marcia was appointed Church Mother of Progressive by Bishop William Cahoon and continued to serve under the leadership of Pastor Alonzo Harley. Marcia continued working in her local and District churches. She was always willing to do what she could to serve the Lord.

She was full of joy and laughter and had a bottomless well of giving to anyone in need. She always remembered the elderly and shut-in Saints. Her sweet, loving spirit will be missed and cherished by all.

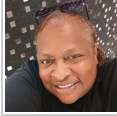
