



Marguerite Edith Lane-Gross

August 14, 1924 - July 19, 2022

Marguerite Edith Lane-Gross was born August 14, 1924 to Marion Edith Jennings and Edward Hawkes Lane in New Brunswick, New Jersey, where she lived most of her young life. She was the eldest of four children: Edward Hawks Jr., William Benjamin and Richard Irving.

She met Buckley S. Gross and they married in 1943. After a stint in the military, former Sgt. Buckley and Marguerite moved to Massachusetts, where they raised three children: Frances, Richard and Robert (Sal Tauhidi).

During the early sixties, she returned to complete her education at Brockton High School, where she received her diploma. She loved history and foreign travel. Her travels included Senegal, Morocco, Egypt, Israel (twice) and England. She worked briefly as a keypunch operator in Boston.

After the death of her husband in 1986 and her eldest son in 1989, she eventually relocated to Virginia where she enjoyed watching her grandchildren grow: Ambrosia, Reheemah and Negoshi. As of 2022, there are eight grandchildren, two great granddaughters and one great grandson.

Alert and independent till the end, she entered her 97th year, continuing to exercise her own enigmatic thoughts and opinions with a quiet resolve. I never heard her say an unkind word about anyone: a glance or casual remark usually reflected what she was thinking.

She will be dearly missed by her family.
