A lifelong Trenton resident, Marie was educated in the Trenton Public School System. She worked for the State of New Jersey Labor Department as a Fraud Insurance Investigator for 35 years, from 1956 until her retirement in 1991.

In 1960, Marie joined New Salem Baptist Church under the pastorate of the late Rev. Philip J. Allen. Marie was a very active member of New Salem Baptist Church. She worked at Anderson Funeral Home for many years.
