Rev. Marion C. Hannah, of Lakewood, NJ, Pastor of the Antioch Christian Church, Disciples of Christ, New Brunswick, died on May 20, 2017. He was predeceased by his wife, Naomi Hannah, on March 3, 2017.

Rev. Hannah served as Pastor of Antioch Christian Church for the last 35 years. He formerly owned and operated Hannah Trucking Co. in Lakewood, NJ for 30 years. He was a former lead singer for the Original Soul Seekers of New Orleans, a well-known gospel group.

His survivors include eleven children, three siblings, a host of grand and great grandchildren, and a multitude of other dear relatives.

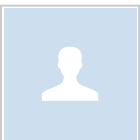
