



## Paulette Debra Moore

April 8, 1953 - April 3, 2024

Paulette Moore was born on April 8, 1953, in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania to the late Gerard and Bella Moore. She departed this life on Wednesday, April 3, 2024, at Saint Peter's University Hospital in New Brunswick after a 2-year battle with cancer.

Paulie or Nana Paulette, as she was affectionately called by family and friends, attended New Brunswick Public Schools. She worked as a caregiver to many children in the family and in the neighborhood where she resided on Joyce Kilmer Avenue for much of her life. She was known to be a big sister to many.
