



Pomp "P.L." Lamons

August 30, 1931 - March 22, 2013

Pomp "P.L." Lamons, 81, died on Friday, March 22, 2013 at Compassionate Care at St. Francis Medical Center.

Born in Pavo, GA and educated in the local public schools, he was a resident of Trenton and Ewing since 1950. He served a tour of duty with the U.S. Marines during the Korean Conflict, was awarded the National Defense Service Medal and was honorably discharged on March 21, 1952. "P.L." worked for many years as a farm contractor, before being employed as a driver by City Beef and Trenton Dressed Poultry. He was also a maintenance worker for Trenton Janitorial Service.
