



Richard James "Nee Amoo" Dodoo

October 7, 1945 - June 13, 2019

Richard James "Nee Amoo" Dodoo, died on June 13, 2019, in Penn Medicine Princeton Medical Hospital of Plainsboro, New Jersey. He was seventy three years old, and he possessed a wisdom and zest for life that spanned the ages before stricken with a stroke.

Richard was born in Ghana, West Africa on October 7, 1945, the son of Richard Ofei Dodoo and Rebecca Akweley Acquaye. He was raised by his Uncle, Edward Ta Wiah Dodoo and his Aunt, Eunice Lena Dodoo. Throughout his youth and adulthood, he was known to be a highly intelligent individual with a love for education and history. He was a loving father.

He received a Bachelor of Arts Degree from Jersey City State College, Jersey City, New Jersey and a Master of Education from Coppin State College in Baltimore, Maryland.

As an educator, he briefly taught junior high school students in the Newark, New Jersey school system prior to moving to the State of Maryland. Richard spent most of his employment years working as a counselor in the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Service in the State of Maryland where he retired. He received from the Governor of the State of Maryland 20 Years of Outstanding Service Governor's Citation for demonstrating high integrity and ability, that merited great trust and respect to the citizens of the

State.

Due to his illness, Richard was transported to New Jersey so his son could take care of him with the support of his mother, Bernistine Nabia Little.

Surviving ones left to cherish his memories are his son, Nee Ofei Dodoo of Pennsylvania, daughter, Jasmine Dodoo of Maryland and a host of relatives residing in the State of Maryland and in the country of Ghana, West Africa and friends.
