



## Roy D Hill

October 14, 1933 - November 17, 2018

Deacon Roy Daniel Hill, husband of Merlene Hill, passed away peacefully on November 17, 2018 at home with his family by his side. Born October 14, 1933 in Wilkes County, Georgia, he was the son of the late Deacon Sam W. Hill and the late Ella P. Hill.

As a young child, Deacon Roy D. Hill accepted Jesus Christ as his Savior. He was baptized and united with Flint Hill Baptist Church under Pastor Frank Welborn's leadership.

Deacon Hill attended Washington High School in Wilkes County, Georgia. After his education was completed, he enlisted in United States Army where he served from 1951-1955. He received an honorable discharge after serving his term.

Deacon Hill worked for Sears for a short period and then for Balwin-Hills until it closed. He retired from the United States Post Office . After retiring, Deacon
