Serita Mae Anderson, affectionately called "Resa", was called to Glory by the Angels on Saturday afternoon, January 21, 2023.

Resa was born in Danville, Virginia on December 3, 1947 and received her early education in the State of Virginia. Moving to Trenton, New Jersey, she attended the public school system and graduated from Trenton Central High School. Resa was employed for many years at Nassau Inn and retired in the late 80's due to health reasons.

After Resa's health began to fail where she could no longer live alone, although she tried her very best, she spent her las declining years in the Preferred Care Nursing Home. She fought a good fight for the last three years by going back and forth from the Nursing Home to the ICU at Capital Health East. Although in the Nursing home during the height of the Pandemic, Resa did not contract Covid. During the year 2022, however, Resa suffered a major stroke which left her speechless and with a paralyzed right diaphragm. Underterred, Resa communicated with family members by using her right hand and arm; waving "hello" or "goodbye" to us; and when she got angry, she would wave that right hand and keep pointing at us, letting us know she didn't agree with what we were saying. The last time she went to Capital Health on January 4th, 2021 was with a series of illnesses and infections that proved to be too muh for her to overcome. Resa was a warrior and fought to

the end until God said, "That's enough, Child, come Home".

Resa is predeceased by her parents, John and Ann Anderson and one brother, Larry Anderson. She leaves to cherish her precious memories seven siblings: Ann Watkins of Ewing, NJ; John (Priscilla) Anderson of Brentwood, California; Audrey Anderson of Levittown, PA; Patricia Anderson of San Jose, CA; Hattie (Thomas) Whittacker of Mercerville, NJ; Sue (Harold) Robinson of Trenton, NJ, Donald (Natalie) Anderson of Gretna, Virginia; and many nieces, nephews, cousins and friends.
