Dr. Virginia E Byrd Tryon was born November 16, 1932 in Trenton, New Jersey to Estella and Luckey Byrd. After completing her early education in the Trenton Public Schools, Virginia went on to earn her Nursing diploma (RN) from Harlem Hospital School of Nursing, NY; a BA in Nursing and a Master in Health Education from Trenton State College; School Supervisor/Administration Certifications from Rider College; and ultimately a Ph.D. in Behavioral Science from Walden University in Florida (1979).

As a lifelong member of Shiloh Baptist Church in Trenton, New Jersey; Virginia served in many ministries such as the Anna Louise White Circle, Ladies Guild, Shiloh Scholarship Committee, Nurses Ministry, and was instrumental in gathering information and pictures to help establish the Shiloh Baptist Church Museum. of the Mercer County Special School District – Non Public Schools, Program Coordinator at the Community College of Philadelphia, Adjunct College Professor at Trenton State College, Tutor for nursing students at Trenton State College, Social Worker for both Trenton and Ewing Township schools and Entrepreneur throughout the region.
