William attended Hampton University where he received a Bachelor of English. He earned a Master of Liberal Studies from New York University and a Master of Education from Lehman College.

He began his career in book publishing. However, he later became a teacher in the New York City Public Schools. William taught students from immigrant families who were learning English as a second language. He was dedicated to helping students succeed.

For five years, he taught business English at universities and companies in Stuttgart, Germany. He became fluent in speaking German.
